③ While holding both sides of the fingers together, gripping the Disc, slide the inner section of the caddy back into the protective case, making sure the tabs click into place.

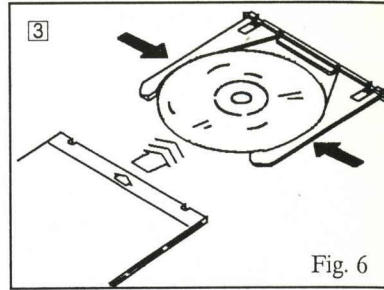

This “Core” or “Applications” disc is an ISO 9660 format CD-ROM containing a file system hierarchy and large number of individual files. These files are components of multiple products and are intended to be copied from the CD only by the HP-UX `/etc/update(1m)` command. HP-UX cannot be booted from this disc, nor are the files intended to be directly executed from this disc. **Do NOT make this disc available (via NFS) to other systems on a network.**

For a complete list of software products present on this CD-ROM, mount the CD-ROM as super-user and examine the file `/update_cdrom/CONTENTS`. Your HP-UX kernel must have ‘`cdfs`’ file system support configured in order to perform the mount. For example, (assuming that you have not changed the default CD device special file and mount-point directory since installing HP-UX from CD-ROM):

```
# /etc/update -c
```

or...

```
# /etc/mount /dev/dsrc /update_cdrom
```

Some software on this Disc is unsecured. You may install and/or update any unsecured software for which you have purchased the required software product license. Other products on this Disc are secured.

To install and/or update secured software requires one or more codewords, supplied by Hewlett-Packard.

Please review the instructions on the CD-ROM Certificate you received with your HP-UX software product purchase. If you did not receive a CD-ROM Certificate, please contact your local Hewlett-Packard sales office or support representative.

If you received this Disc as part of a Hewlett-Packard Software Support Service, the shipment includes a CD-ROM Certificate entitled "Codeword to Install Software," with one or more codewords pre-printed on the first page of the certificate.

If you received this Disc as part of a one-time purchase order that also included software license purchases, you may have received a "CD-ROM Certificate" with one or more pre-printed codewords. If you DID NOT receive pre-printed codewords on your CD-ROM Certificate, refer to the "Contacting HP to Obtain Your Codewords" section of this booklet.

With CD-ROM Certificates that contain pre-printed codewords, if "NONE" appears in the codeword field for a particular Compact Disc, then one of the following applies:

Contacting HP to Obtain Your Codeword(s)

Follow the instructions in this section if you did not receive a pre-printed codeword on your CD-ROM Certificate. This section applies only if you received a CD-ROM certificate with a CODEWORD SUBMITTAL FORM. A sample of this form is shown in Figure 1. Do not Fax this sample to HP.

1. To obtain your codeword(s), complete the CODEWORD SUBMITTAL FORM you received with your CD-ROM certificate and Fax it to Hewlett-Packard anytime Monday thru Sunday. You will receive one unique codeword per secured Compact Disc. **IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A FAX MACHINE, CONTACT YOUR LOCAL HP SALES OFFICE.**

To ensure that HP can quickly and accurately process your information, when you fill out the CODEWORD SUBMITTAL FORM, please print all characters in BLACK or BLUE pen to look like the block letters in the sample below.

2. To provide you with a codeword, HP requires the information listed below:
 - a. The part numbers from the HP-UX Compact Disc set that contains the software product(s) you need to access. There is one part number printed on the face of each Compact Disc. (For example: Part No.: B23x8-136xx)
Copy the 10-digit part numbers from the "Core OS" and "Applications" Discs. DO NOT copy the part numbers from the "Install," "Support," or "HP Software Store" Discs (these Discs contain no software protected by HP codewords).
 - b. Choose a "Hardware ID Number" from one of the hardware devices listed below. The codewords you are issued will secure installation of the software to the hardware device you specify.

12 characters long

HP C1707A 6100/600A HP-IB CD-ROM Drive
Printed on rear panel and reported by "/etc/update -i" with use of HP-UX 8.0 update (1M)

10 characters long

SPECIAL NOTE about Hardware IDs:

- HP strongly recommends using the HP-HIL ID Module as the Hardware ID source for most workstation configurations.
- CD-ROM drives other than the HP C1707A, cannot be used for Hardware ID purposes. In this case, the only available Hardware ID sources are the HP-HIL ID Module or the HP SPU ID.
- For diskless cluster configurations, software may only be installed/updated on the server, and must be secured to the server's Hardware ID (i.e. execute "/etc/update -i" on the server, and not on a client). If the server is an HP 9000 Series 800 multi-user "S" system, the HP-HIL ID Module will not be available as a Hardware ID.

3. When sending the CODEWORD SUBMITTAL FORM to Hewlett-Packard refer to the Phone Number Reference page included with your CD-ROM Certificate. For your convenience, the Phone Number Reference page provides you with a worldwide list HP Fax telephone numbers. You will receive the same response time, regardless of the Fax telephone number that you call. Send your CODEWORD SUBMITTAL FORM to the Fax telephone number nearest you.

You will receive your codeword(s) via Fax within 24 working hours (Monday thru Friday, not including holidays). Because typical Fax paper fades with time, HP recommends that you copy each codeword to the labels provided with your CD-ROM Certificate. You can affix the labels to this booklet or other relevant documentation. DO NOT affix the labels to your CD-ROM caddy as this may cause problems when loading the Compact Disc into a CD-ROM drive.

Enter your codeword when called for in the installation procedure. Please enter all 16 or 29 codeword characters, without any separating blank spaces.

5. If you experience problems or do not receive your codeword(s) within 24 working hours (Monday thru Friday, not including holidays), please contact your Hewlett-Packard sales office or support representative.
