
IMPORTANT: If you do not attach the tags, there will be a substantial delay in the return of the repaired element due to the time required by IBM to determine the unit's maintenance status.















Attach feet to keyboard (optional).

Note: If you want your keyboard to have a higher angle, attach the feet.












4 Attach stand to video element.







Canadian Standard Association (CSA) Certification requires that the stand be attached to the video element. This CSA Certification is void if the stand is not installed or if it is removed after installation.














f Pull the stand gently toward you until it stops.




G Slowly lower the front of the stand so that the front hooks on the stand enter the front slots on the video element.




Lock the stand to the video element by setting the latch parallel to the edge facing you.




Make sure the stand is locked to the video element.







6 Set video element in place.



7 Set keyboard in place.






b Insert the keyboard cable and tighten the screws.







Your screen should look similar to this. (You do not have to check each character.) Move the A/A,a switch; the characters should change between all uppercase and mixed uppercase and lowercase.






17 Set TEST/NORMAL switch to 18 Set I/O switch to 0 (Off). NORMAL.






